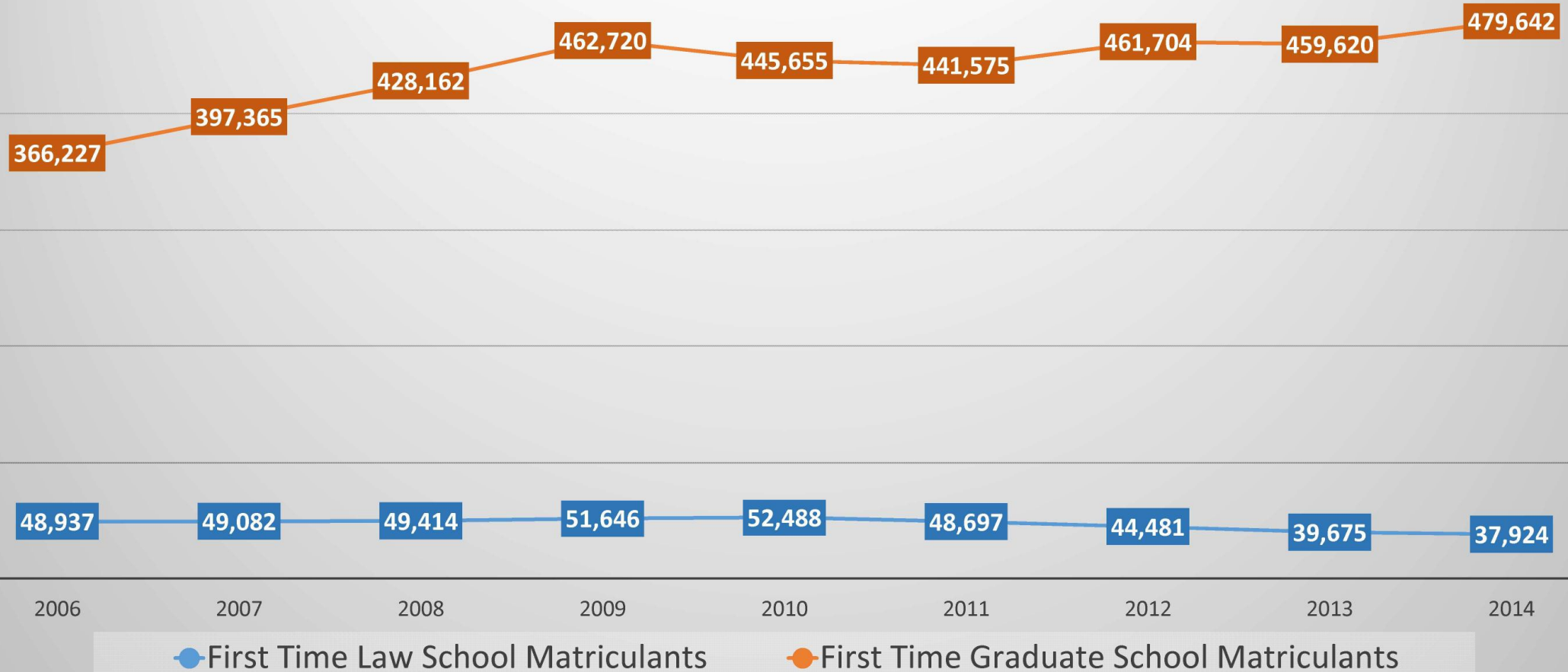
Law School and Graduate School Applications

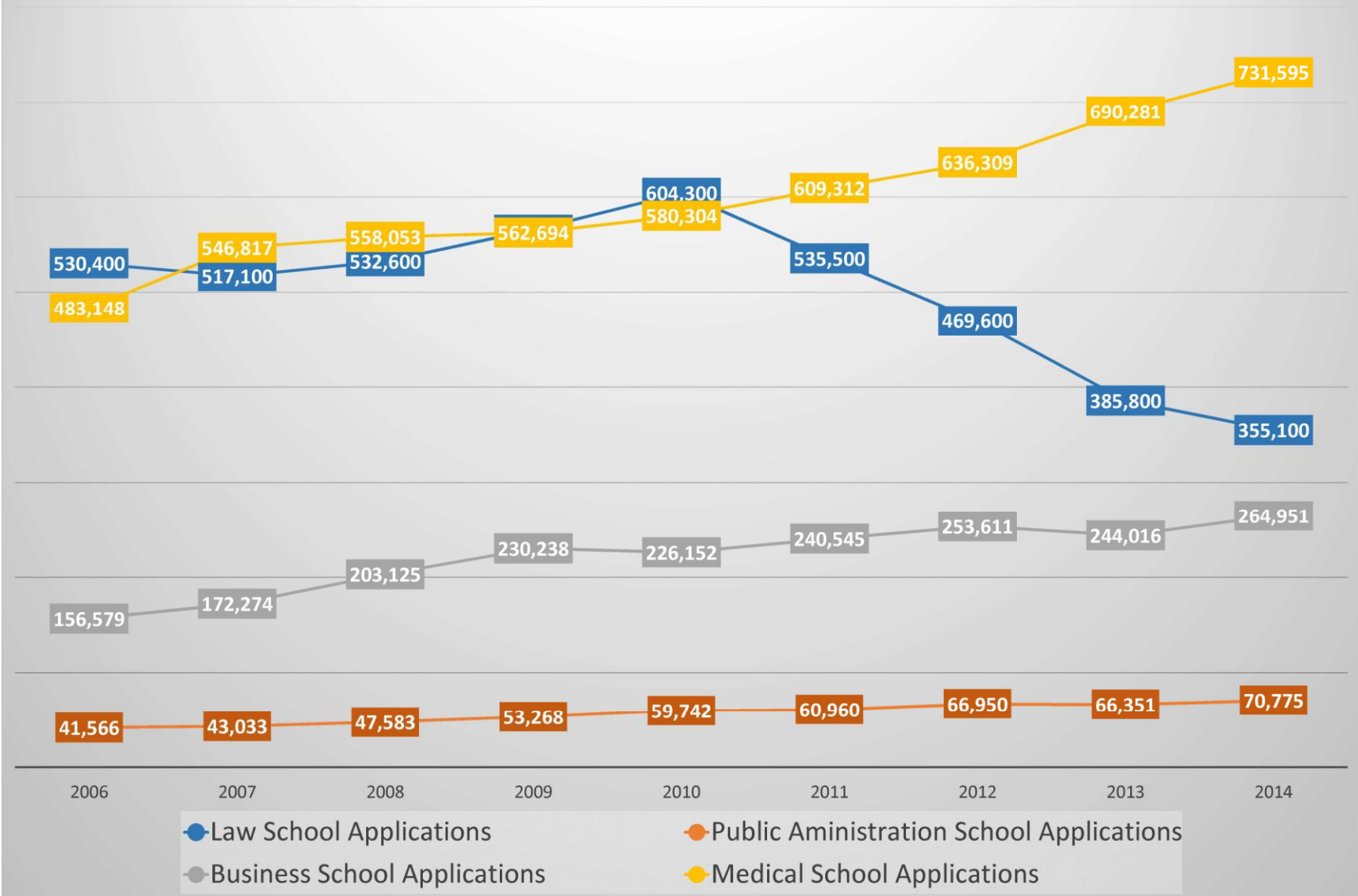
Law School and Graduate School Matriculants

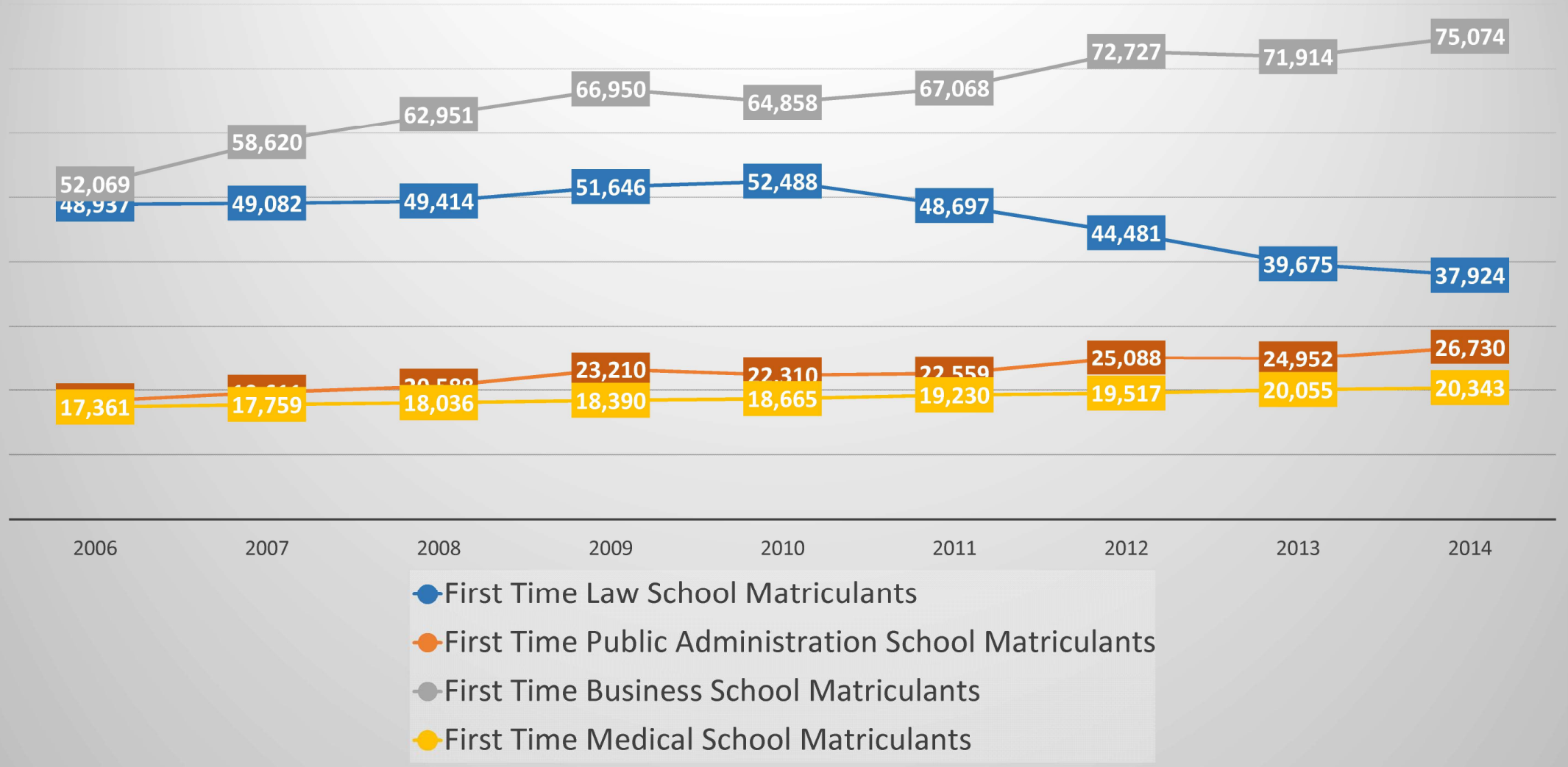

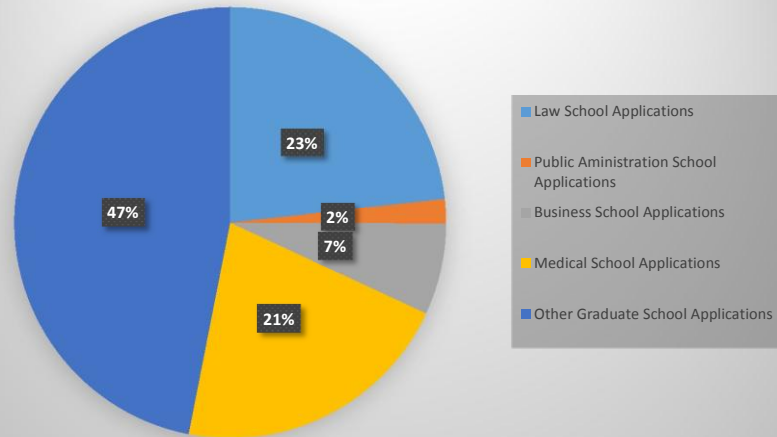


First Time Graduate School Matriculants

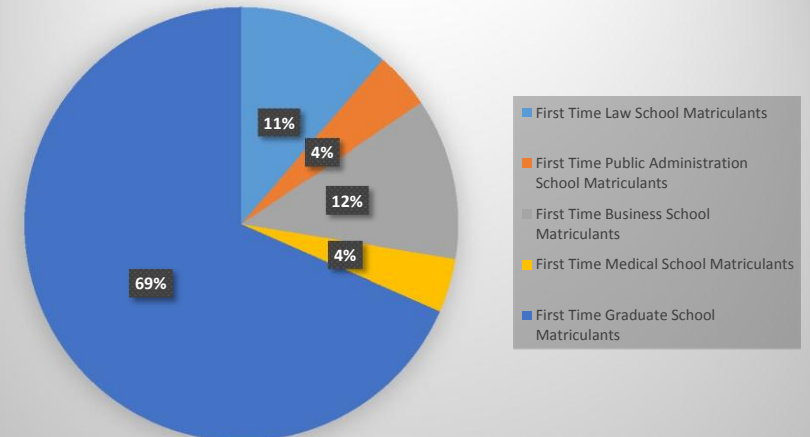

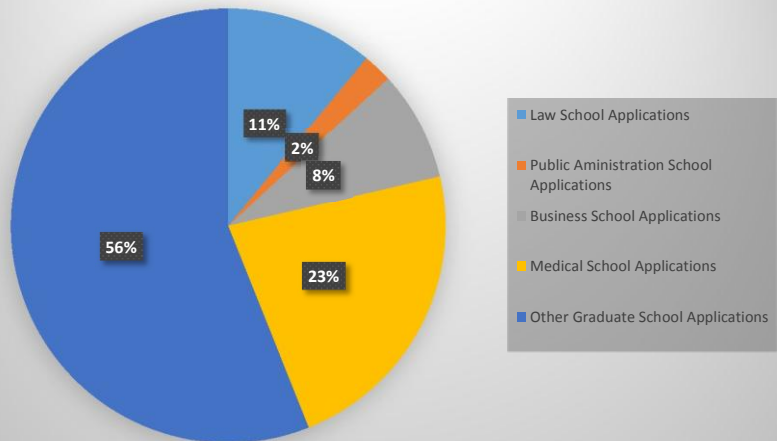
Graduate Applications in 2006



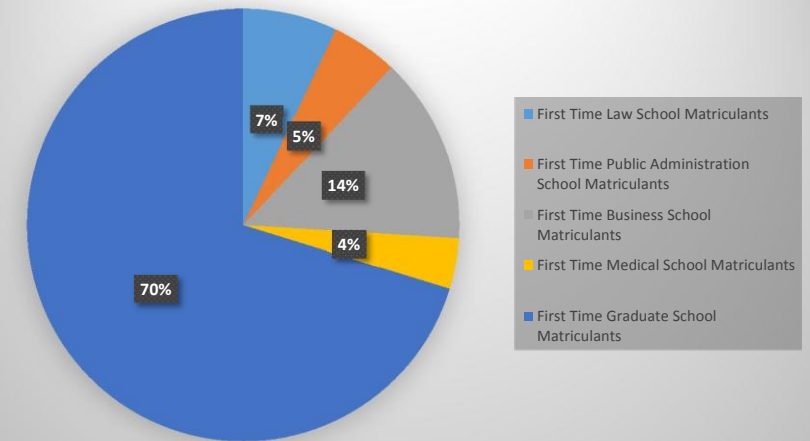
Graduate School Matriculants in 2006

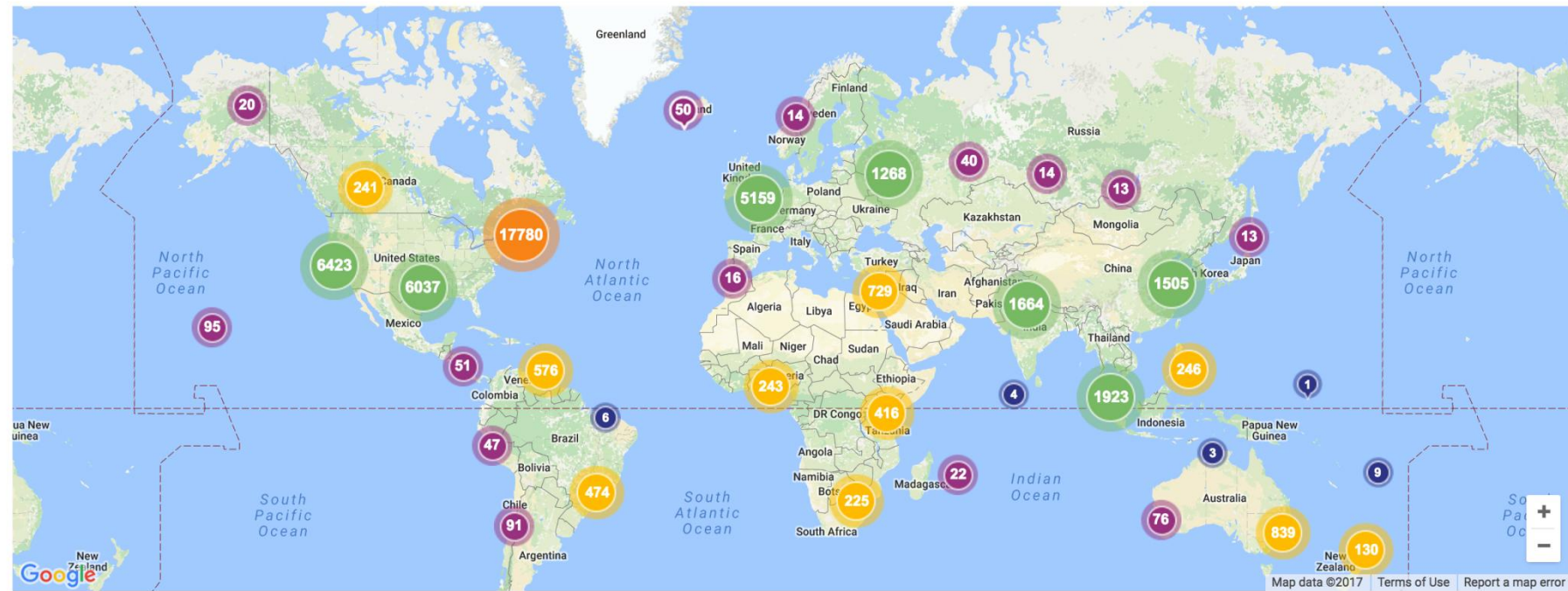
