Hubbard Law & Education Conference Endowment to fund biennial conferences recognizing and disseminating innovative and significant scholarship on law and education. The conferences supported by this endowment will honor William C. Hubbard's lifelong contribution to the legal profession and his enduring interest in law and education.



Past conferences and webinars supported by the Hubbard Conference Endowment considered topics like the state of legal education, democracy, and the future of the legal profession. The ABF extends its gratitude to hosts and co-sponsors of past Hubbard Conferences, Stanford University School of Law and University of South Carolina School of Law. The Hubbard Conferences have brought together prominent scholars and practitioners to facilitate the dissemination of research and to stimulate new lines of inquiry. Papers presented

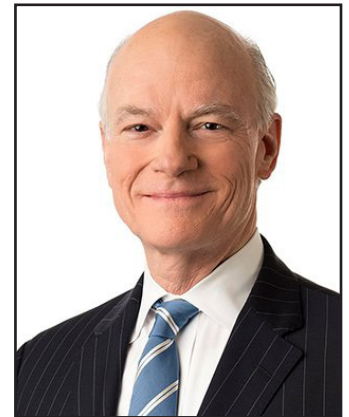
at the conference are subsequently published in law reviews or academic presses, underscoring the ABF's commitment to the proliferation of cutting-edge research.

About William C. Hubbard

William C. Hubbard is Dean and Professor of Law at the University of South Carolina School of Law. He served as President of the ABF, the American Bar Association (ABA), and the American Bar Endowment (ABE), and past Chair of the ABA House of Delegates.

Hubbard spent his career as an attorney and partner with Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP in Columbia, South Carolina. He is a co-founder and Chair of the Board of Directors of the World Justice Project, a multinational, multidisciplinary initiative to strengthen the rule of law worldwide.

He is a Trustee of the University of South Carolina, a Leadership Fellow of the ABF, a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, an Honorary Master of the Bench of Middle Temple in London, and a member of the Council of the American Law Institute as well as the Leaders Council of the Legal Services Corporation. Hubbard was recognized with the University of South Carolina's Honorary Doctor of Laws and Distinguished Alumni Award. He received his B.A. and J.D. from the University of South Carolina, served on the university's Board of Trustees and as Chair of the Board.
